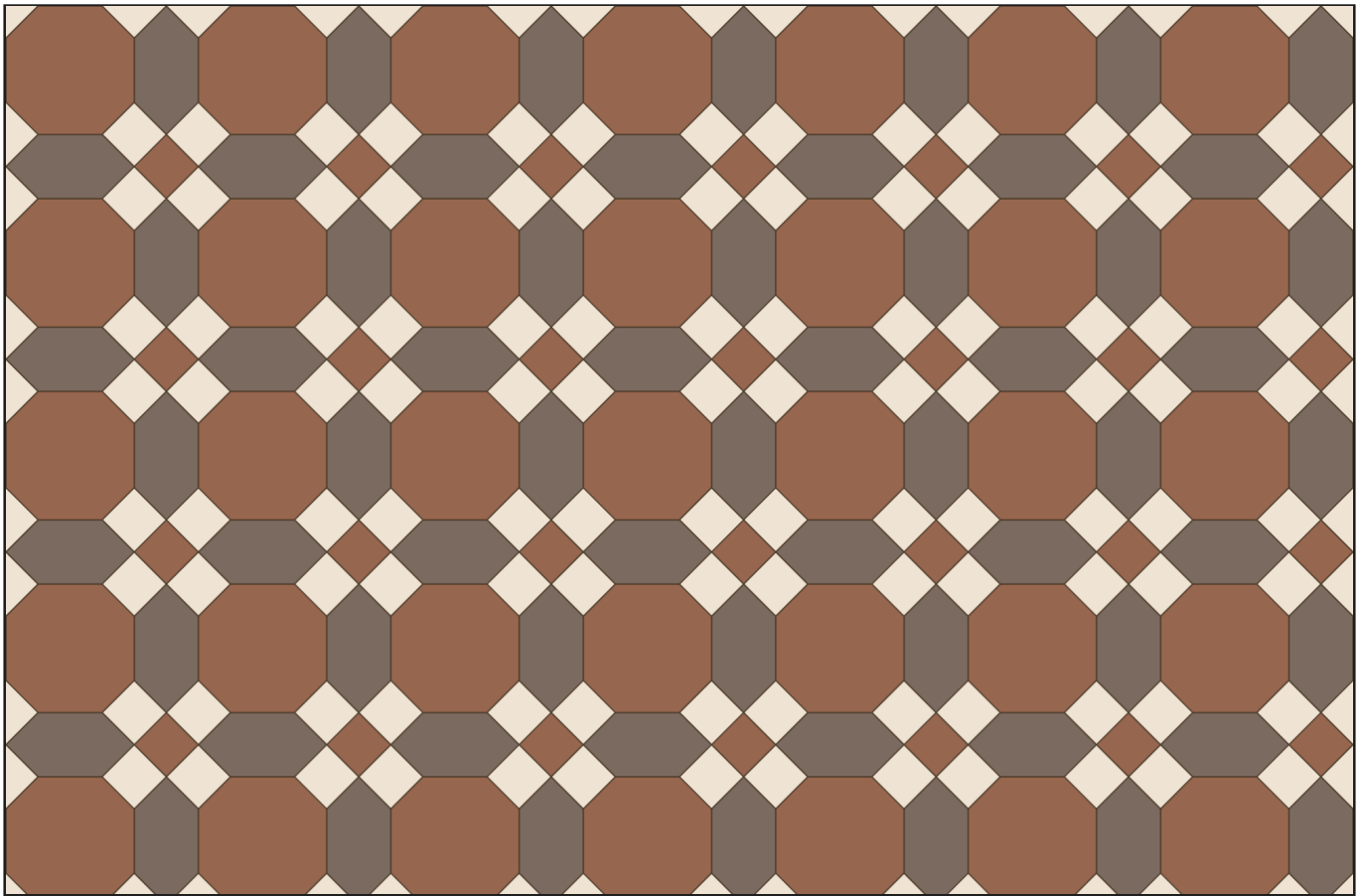


Bendigo, 100

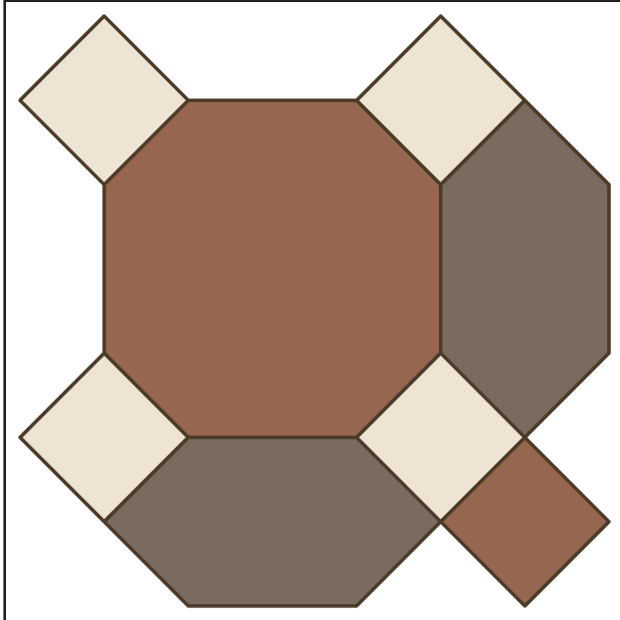
- 20** Brick-red

TILE SCHEDULE

ZONE	TILE
A	Octagon
B	Hexagon, elongated
C	Dot, square
D	Dot, square

The same Bendigo floor at the smaller 100 octagon (96 mm actual), with 29 mm dots. Suits hallways and entries. Suits hallway, path, verandah.

ONE REPEAT



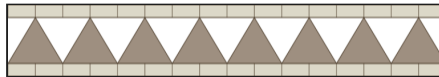
One repeat, drawn to the pattern pitch.

BORDERS THAT SUIT THIS PATTERN



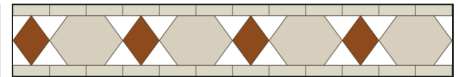
Norwood
