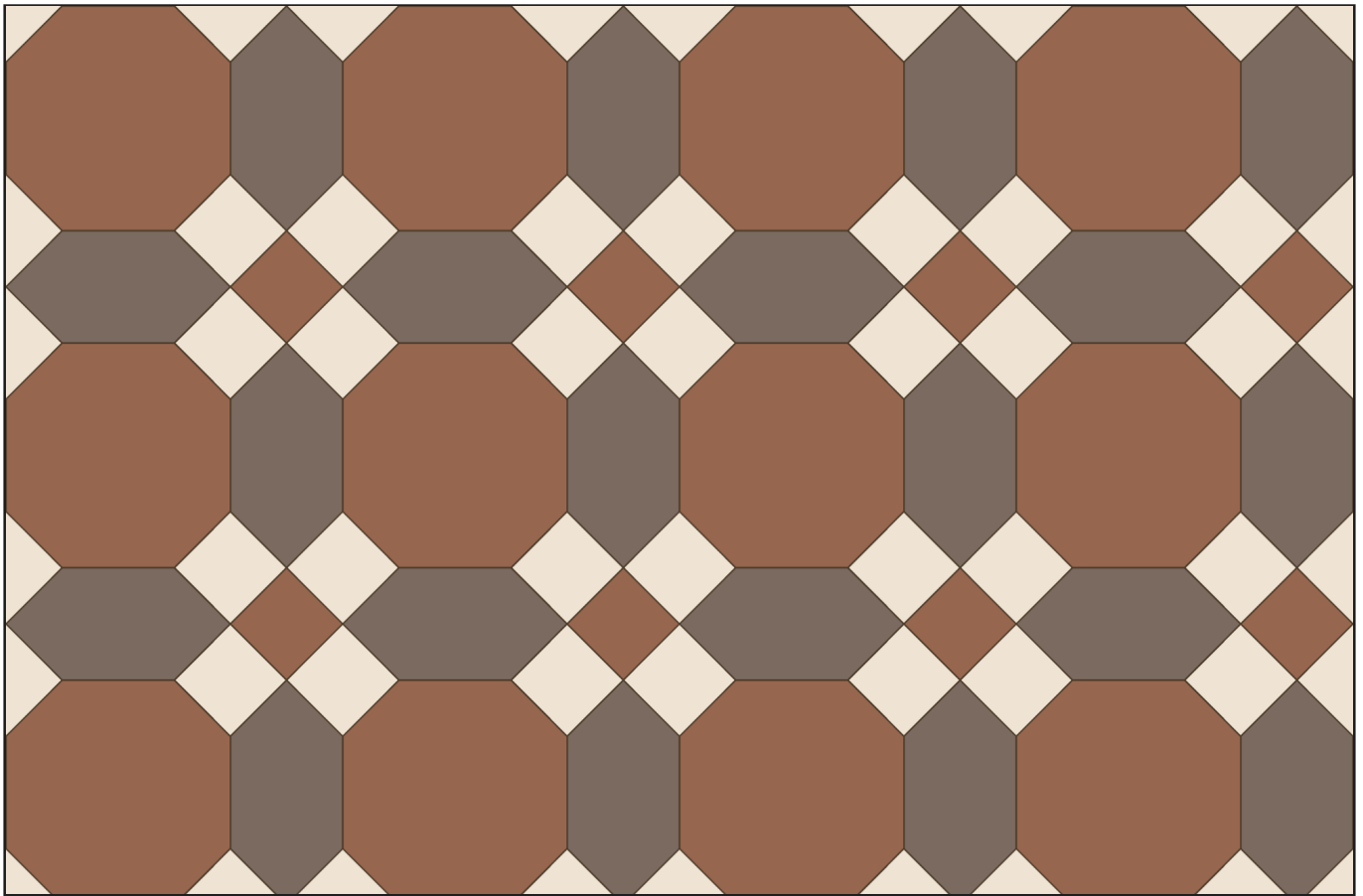


# Bendigo, 150

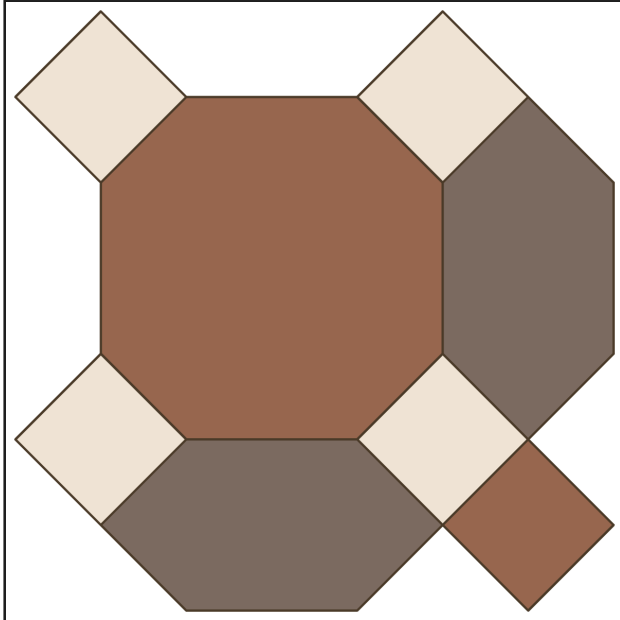

## TILE SCHEDULE

| ZONE     | TILE               |
|----------|--------------------|
| <b>A</b> | Octagon            |
| <b>B</b> | Hexagon, elongated |
| <b>C</b> | Dot, square        |
| <b>D</b> | Dot, square        |

Brown 150 octagons (146 mm actual) with a dark tile between them and cream 47 mm dots at every crossing. The classic goldfields verandah floor. Suits hallway, path, verandah.

## ONE REPEAT



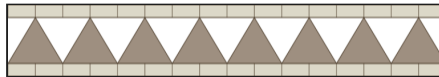
One repeat, drawn to the pattern pitch.

## BORDERS THAT SUIT THIS PATTERN



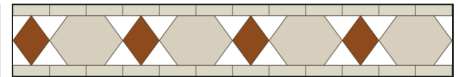
### Norwood
