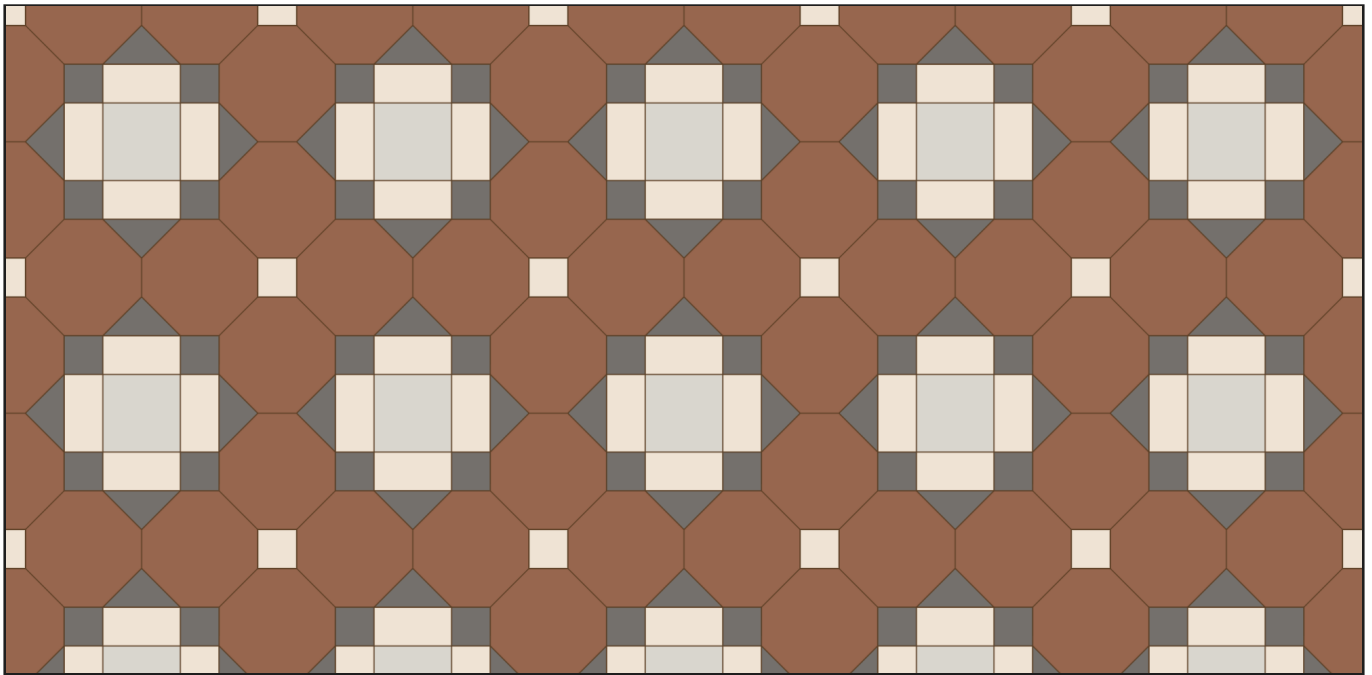


Bowral

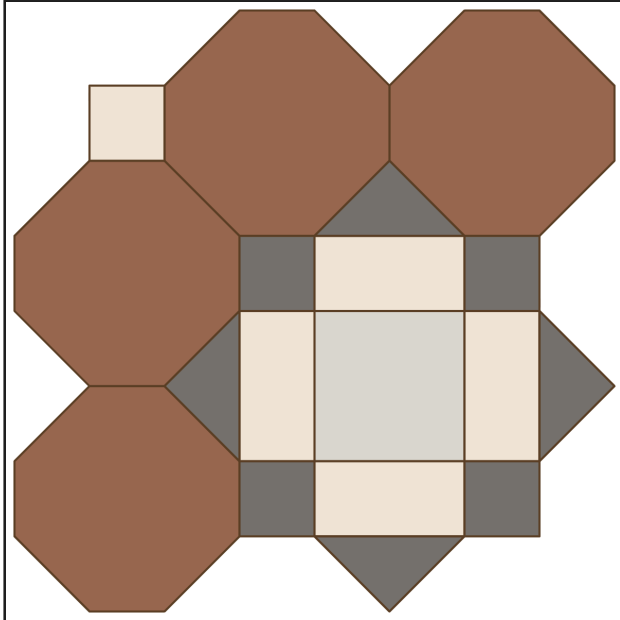
- 20** Brick-red

TILE SCHEDULE

ZONE	TILE
A	Octagon
B	Motif tile, square
C	Rectangle
D	Dot, square
E	Dot, square
F	Half square

Octagon and dot turned on the diagonal, with a cross of cream and charcoal around a motif tile every few units. Suits entry, hallway, verandah.

ONE REPEAT



One repeat, drawn to the pattern pitch.

BORDERS THAT SUIT THIS PATTERN



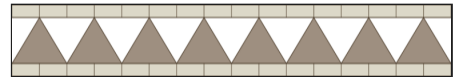
