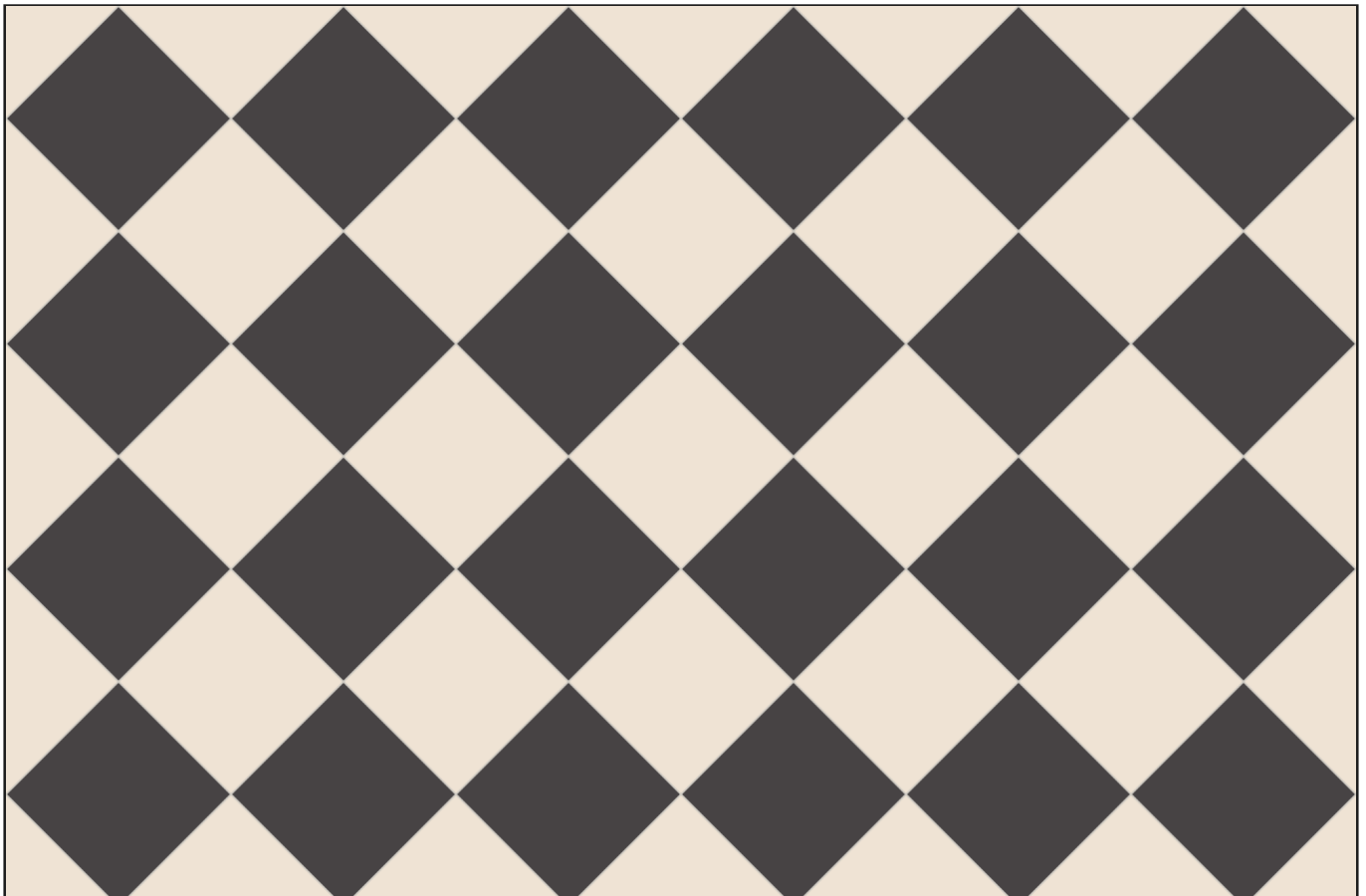


Checkerboard

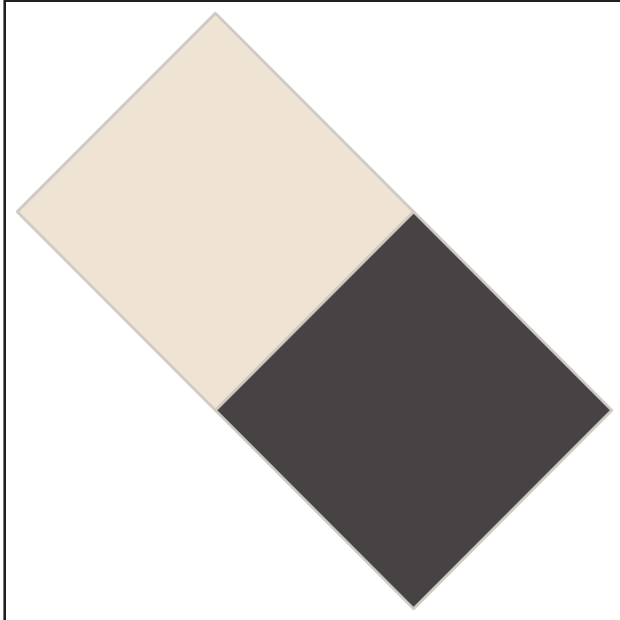

TILE SCHEDULE

ZONE	TILE
A	Square
B	Square

Black and white 100 mm squares laid on the diagonal. The simplest floor in the book, and still the one that makes the most of a long path. Suits kitchen, path, verandah.

One repeat, drawn to the pattern pitch.

BORDERS THAT SUIT THIS PATTERN



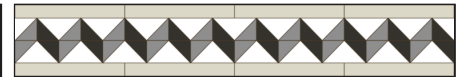
